



Grand Rapids Area Fishing Report 6-7-2010

Another week into the 2010 Open Water Season. I can't believe how fast things are moving this summer.

The past couple of days I have spent most my time on mid lake humps and bars. Not to say there isn't fish still on the shorelines but most the action is coming from the deeper mid lake structure.

We have been targeting mainly smaller mid lake humps that top off in 15'-20' of water. Most of these humps are only big enough on top for two or three boats. When locating these humps make sure you are watching your

Electronics while checking not only the top of the hump but also the sides and the base. If you don't see anything move on to the next one. If we do see fish we are dropping a 1/4oz Fireball tipped with a shiner. You can normally pull 2-3 fish before it fizzles out and you are forced to move to the next piece of structure.



We are just starting to see 6' Roach Rigs with a leech work nicely also. Another area that is producing for us is finding shoreline points that reach miles out into the lake and connect to humps and bars mid lake. Fish are transitioning and these



are working like a sidewalk in a busy city.

There are also several bug hatches coming from the deeper structure right now and most the fish we catch have larvae in their teeth but at this point it hasn't seem to effect the bite.

If the wind slows down a bit the fishing seems to follow but we have stayed on them and picked them off one by one. Also if the wind tends to gust we get a nice little burst of action.

If you are a Roach Rig guy now is the time to get them ready. Summer patterns and action are just getting started!
